What is the purpose of the project?

The aim is to create a database of realistic cocaine-related images for use in future studies to understand brain changes resulting from cocaine use and to find potential treatments for cocaine addiction.

Are there any reasons why I can't take part?

You cannot take part if you:

- are **currently in treatment** to reduce or stop cocaine use
- have a diagnosis of **schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, psychotic depression, bipolar disorder, or organic brain disease**
- have felt **suicidal** or made a **suicide attempt** within the **past 6 months**

This study has been approved by the **King's College London Research Ethics Committee** [HR-25/26-54854]. Your data will be strictly confidential and will be stored securely in accordance with GDPR.
